Poised at a critical juncture of demographic milestones, public health advances, massive human migrations and developmental concerns, the **Indian Institute of Technology, Gandhinagar (IITGN)** along with the College of Arts & Science, **University of Saskatchewan, Canada** are jointly convening a Summer Institute on Global Health & Development that will offer a unique opportunity to engage, empower and prepare young researchers in their global pursuits for a healthy, equitable and sustainable world. Through debates, talks and hands-on training sessions on cutting edge interdisciplinary methodologies, the Institute will allow participants to examine how the scientific community at large can contribute to a sharper understanding of the complex interlinkages of health and development policies.

Hands-on training sessions include a combination of qualitative and quantitative methodologies e.g. survey design, multilevel analysis, qualitative analysis using NVivo, mixed methods, digital humanities, proposal writing and GIS-based spatial regression methods.

This highly selective residential program is targeted to students, junior faculty at colleges / universities, program & research staff at strategic monitoring and planning divisions of think-tanks / NGOs and government officials who are either actively engaged or considering to work on related fields of health & development.
