Dance duet@home

- You have to record a dance video on your phone with a family member or friend. Your dance partner could be anyone except any person associated with IITGN
- The video clip must be at least 30 seconds long.
- You are free to choose any dance genre.
- So, shake a leg!



Painting

- You can paint using any medium – canvas, paper, cloth or on your computer.
- You are expected to paint a scene depicting "Technology of future"
- Feel free to supplement your artwork with a 200-word abstract.
- Share your artwork as a PDF (take a picture and convert it to PDF)
- Unearth the painter in you!



Ad enact

- You have to shoot an advertisement video on your mobile phone to publicise any household object – pen, broomstick, glasses, cutlery, etc.
- The video must be at least 30 seconds.
- You have the opportunity to make it fun and compelling.



Making a catapult

- Designing a working model of a catapult from waste household stuff (only).
- You'll be required to share the total distance covered by the projectile and its weight along with visual proof.
- The visual proof will be a video clip shot at the time of the release.
- Calibrate your angle of launch to maximise the result.



Book review

- You are expected to write a minimum of 500 words on any one of the following books.
- Suggested titles – Eat Pray and Love, Sapiens, Thinking Fast and Slow, 100 years of Solitude, A Promised Land and The Alchemist
- Rediscover the bibliophile in you!



Photography

- You are expected to submit three photographs based on the following themes.
- You are permitted to use your mobile phone cameras
- Themes – Food, Sunset/Sunrise, Monochrome, Reflective Photography, Flowers.
- Watch out for the shutter speed!



Boardgame aficionados

- Boardgame enthusiasts are free to design on any new or adapt existing games (say a Monopoly based in IITGN).
- You can design it on paper or your computer and share it with us.
- Roll the dice!



Design a Logo

- We are inviting you to share your designs that can be used as the logo of this newly created centre.

- This is an 'open' category and you can showcase any activity on short video clip or a note.
- It can anything – Poem Recitation, Singing, Slam Poetry, or Stand-up Comedy.
- Or it can be any interests that are not covered in the above categories – Gardening, Cooking or Philately. As we mentioned, this category without any boundaries.
- Participants are expected to share a short video or a PDF note whichever works in your case.
